2021 Mint Valley 2-Person Best Ball

Details

Tournament Date: April 17, 2021. Tee times will start at 7:00 AM.

Entry Fee: \$60 per team. Submit payment with completed paper entry form to the Pro Shop. Entry forms that are not filled out completely are subject to disqualification.

Entry Includes: Payouts for tournament winners (gross and net), closest to pin, and skins. The number of tournament winners will be determined by the size of field.

Entry Deadline: April 14, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.

Eligibility: Entries are open to all golfers (male, female, or junior) who have a current USGA Handicap Index.

Field Limit: Field is limited to the first 40 teams.

Format: 18-hole best ball stroke play (gross and net). Maximum handicap difference of 8 strokes between teammates (USGA Handicap Index). Teams with a greater spread may play together but the high handicapper will be adjusted down to meet the 8-stroke spread.

Recording strokes: At least one member of the team must hole out. Each player records gross score on their team scorecard. The tournament committee will calculate best gross and net score for each hole. For pace of play considerations, please pick up your ball once you reach net double bogey (as long as your partner will hole out) and record your net double bogey score on the scorecard. Net double bogey is the maximum strokes allowed for handicap posting purposes.

Flights: Two flights; the field will be split down the middle based on average team handicap.

Handicap: 85% of Course Handicap. Handicap Indexes on April 14, 2021 will be used for the tournament. Maximum USGA Handicap Index is set at 36.4 for males and 40.4 for females.

Tee Marker: White Tees with option to play the Gold Tees if your Age + USGA Handicap Index is 82 or greater. If you meet this requirement and want to play the Gold Tees, indicate this on the entry form. All other players must play from the White Tees.

Rules Summary (Full details will be emailed to participants two days before the event):

- Preferred lies – We are playing the ball “up”.
- Bunker Relief – Relief in the bunker when your ball lies in a disturbed area.
- Racquet & Fitness Building Relief – One club length from the white line.
- Red Penalty Areas – Includes all tall grass areas and hillsides on #3, #5 and #6.
- Yellow Penalty Area – Forced carry on #17. Drop zone available in front of the Gold Tees.
- Out of bounds – Fences, including the fence around the driving range.
